What is a Supported Internship?

A Supported Internship is a Programme funded by the Education and Skills Funding Agency, for adults with additional needs who want to gain experience in the world of work.

The Programme aims to give the Intern real work experience that will possibly lead to voluntary or paid employment.

Each Intern will be fully supported by a Job Coach until such time that they are able to work independently.



What support is on offer?

Each Intern will have regular contact with a Job Coach, who will make sure their placement is going to plan. They will have daily contact with them and will assess how much support is required at each stage of their internship.

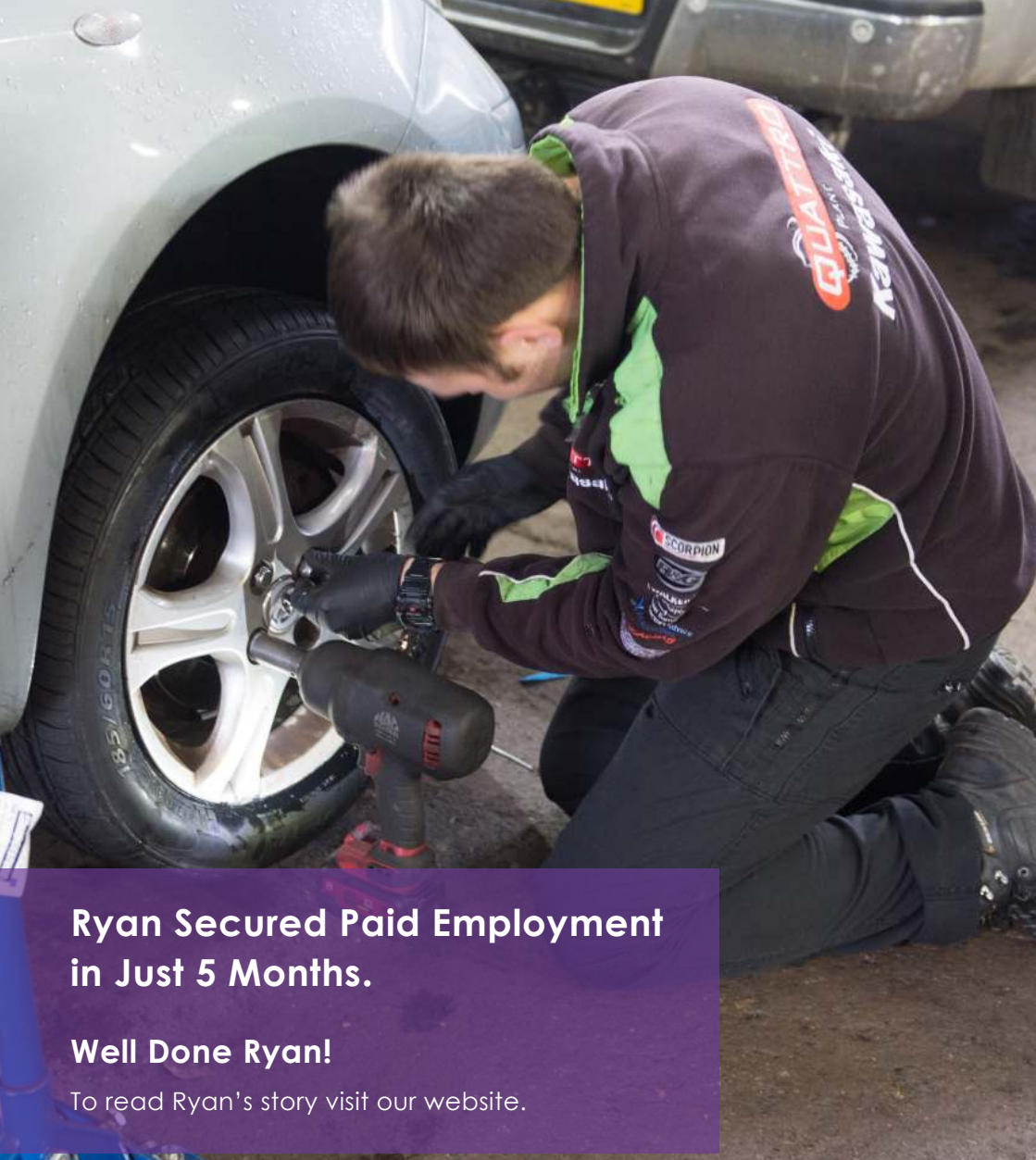
We will also be in regular communication with you to see how well the Intern is settling in.
